1. Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance were read aloud.
2. GK Conen summarized the Revised Minutes from the June meeting for all and requested any revisions from the floor. Jake Kluch motioned to approve the minutes as amended, seconded by Jim Michel. Motion carried unanimously.
3. GK Conen asked if any new members were present or non-Knights, non- Council. Father Boniface was an honored guest, along with Brother Knight David Rak-Kinonen.

5. Father Bill's remarks:  
Eucharistic Revival begins July 17<sup>th</sup>, after the Blessed Sacrament was conveyed over 6,000 miles, walking two routes that converged on Indianapolis. This is the first Eucharistic Revival convention in 86 years. EWTN and other sources are carrying live coverage.
6. Jim Michel: Our own Eucharistic Revival action is to extend Adoration on Thursdays to the whole day each week. Each adoration will end with Benediction after Reconciliation concludes at about 6 p.m. Volunteers are needed to be with Our Lord after Divine Mercy until about 6 p.m.
7. Mike Ward: Financial Report

8. Women's Auxiliary operates as a social group, are ready to help the Knights anyway they can.

10. We will have the installation of new officers soon.
11. Rich Stone: OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) has started information sessions on Saturdays, starting July 20<sup>th</sup>. It is never too late to join, as this is the inquiry time with actual courses beginning in October. They meet in the Pastoral Care Center.
12. Father Boniface and Brother Knights David Rak-Kinonen told us about the Hands of Christ organization they co-founded to benefit Ugandan Youth. They showed pictures of the schools that were and are being built to teach trades through a multi-purpose hall. 13. Father Bill: Community  
Announced the Coats for Kids are ready to swing into action. Eight cases equal 192 coats. Last year the distribution was between Vally View and Santa Teresita Church.
14. Life: Thank you received from First Way Pregnancy Center for sponsoring Ultrasound machine. Mike Ward reported that council donated \$20k. Supreme usually matches with another \$20k. Total cost was \$62k, and Supreme donated \$42k.

Also, Jim Michel mentioned that the Mass with Persons with Intellectual Disabilities and Healing Mass details are being developed with Fr. Shea and the parish staff.

15. New Business: DGK Ed Hoover made a motion that up to \$1000 be donated for Coats for Kids purchase of ten cases. Charles Leddon seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously.
16. Planning meeting for officers and directors for Fraternal Year activity planning. Input from all members solicited. A budget meeting will also be scheduled for August, which will yield a budget brought to the members twice for approval. This makes budgeting more efficient, as budgeted expenditures do not need further approval.
17. Safe Environment Training must be renewed for ALL parish volunteers.
18. Bernadette's Brew is the weekend following the meeting in July. Food Handler training is required if you handle food at parish events. Costs of Food Handler training will be reimbursed by the council.
