2025 MARCH FOR LIFE PHOENIX MARCH 15TH

Arizona passed one of the most liberal abortion laws in the County when it enacted Proposition 139. As Knights, we are committed, in the name of our Blessed Mother Mary, to protecting the life of unborn children.

The Annual March for Life demonstration in Phoenix takes place on March 15th at the Wesley Bolin Memorial Plaza, 1700 W. Washington St..

The March for Life began in 1974 as a response to the Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade decision that legalized abortion nationwide. With the overturn of Roe v. Wade, pro-lifers still gather to march for the lives of unborn children as abortion continues to be legal in many states.
