Message from Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly on 125th Anniversary of the 4th Degree

"Today the question is not whether Catholics can be patriots...We hear that patriotism means the same thing as blind nationalism, that it tends toward arrogance, aggression, and advancing one country's interests at the expense of others.

However, as Knights and as members of the fourth degree, we refuse to accept these lies. On the contrary, we stand for the true meaning of patriotism.

Our church teaches us that patriotism is not and never has been about national supremacy, nor is it a call to exclude or vilify the foreigner or the immigrant. It's not a weapon to be used against other nations or peoples. Rather, the church reminds us that patriotism is a duty that flows from a sense of gratitude gratitude to God, gratitude to our family, and gratitude to our nation for the gifts that we have been given, the gifts that shape and sustain us: hearth and home, church, culture, and community."

We currently have 210 members, a net gain of two for 2025, with 13 members having joined us this fraternal year (since 7/1/2024). We have 40 members in arrears for dues for 24-25, with a total in owed dues of \$2,741.00. One member has transferred to Prince of Peace with outstanding dues, so we will be credited for his dues when his transfer is complete. ANY member in arrears can contact the GK or FS to make arrangements to resolve the dues issues. I am also pursuing the Affiliate Member Initiative for approximately 15 Brothers, which will remove them from our council and allow the State Council to attempt to contact them.

I'd like each member to contact me to update your information in the Knights of Columbus database. This includes having your spouse, children, responsible person listed, so that they can be contacted in an emergency, or to make final arrangements. Additionally, we'd like to update your "interests" areas, so that our FIA and other directors can help your membership become more active, and so that we know what interests the council should pursue.

Lenten Program-Great Participation

"Our Lenten Journey with Jesus" was the theme of the Knights parish Lenten devotion program. We are deeply grateful to our prayer-filled and generous parish for supporting the program with their devotional diligence and donations. Through this program we raised over \$2200 to help with our parish' goal of expanding the Adoration Chapel.

From the Deputy Grand Knight

As Knights of Columbus we do an awful lot of great work. As we approach the end of the current fraternal year on June 30 we look both back on what we've accomplished and forward to the opportunities in front of us. We just completed both the Lenten Fish Fry and State Raffle Ticket fund raisers which generate funds for our parish and local charities. Together over \$15000 was raised to support our Parish, First Way Pregnancy Center, Catholic Education, and St Vincent DePaul. This past year our Faith in Action Program Directors led the way in programs and fund raising. The Faith Program launched the COR dialogue providing men of the parish (not just Knights) with the opportunity to deepen their faith through prayer and study. The Life Program led a group from our Parish to the March for Life in downtown Phoenix. The Community Program once again through Coats for Kids distributed 200 coats along with scarves, mittens and gift cards bringing smiles and gratitude from children and their families. This program area also spearheaded multiple food and water drives donating food and over \$3300 to Valley View Community Food Bank. The Family Program raised \$2650 Continued page 6

Our Council conducted a very successful Lenten fish fry fundraiser this year. We distributed 1058 dinners and generated over \$7800 which will be divided between our Parish and other local charities. - Plans, organizes and conducts the annual Lenten Fish Fry
- Coordinates with Parish Staff for permission to use kitchen facilities and equipment and assure that the kitchen area and all equipment are properly cleaned and stored.
- Purchases supplies, recruits staff, assures food handler compliance.
- Coordinates with the Public Relations Chair for publicity and promotional assistance and with the Financial Secretary and Treasurer for handling of donations raised.

Social and Parish Events Committee, Chair. Larry Bonno

- Plans, organizes and implements social events to build camaraderie and cohesiveness among members and spouses/significant others.
- A primary focus of this Committee is to provide encouragement of fraternal relationships and build a cohesive Council.
- Responds to requests from the Parish to assist with occasional social oriented parish events as.
- Organizing and staffing Bernadette's Brew on assigned Sunday.

Raffle Ticket Promotion Committee, Chair, TBD

- Plans, organizes and implements the annual State Charity Raffle Ticket promotion.
- Coordinates raffle ticket sales by members, weekend raffle ticket sales after Masses, sales of raffle tickets at other venues as appropriate, receipt of monies from sales and transfer to the Financial Secretary for accounting.
- Coordinates with Parish to set up ticket sales booths and with the Public Relations Chair for publicity and promotional assistance
